Pray to put on the Shoes of Readiness. Lord, I pray that my feet would be fitted with the readiness given by the gospel of peace. Help me step into that readiness and walk firm confident in that peace which comes from my relationship with You. Help me to share the gospel with others that they may have peace.

Pray as you secure the Shield of Faith.

Lord, I take up the shield of faith. I depend on You; help me not to doubt or worry. I trust You, the Faithful One and in Your promises to which You are faithful. I trust You to provide for my needs. But more than this, I trust You to quench every fiery dart the enemy throws my way. I will not be shaken, rather, I will trust in you each day regardless of my circumstances.

Pray as you put on the Helmet of Salvation. Lord, knowing my salvation in Christ is a gift, I put on the helmet of salvation. I believe Jesus died, paying the penalty for my sins and rose from the grave, saving me from eternal death. Pray to take up the Sword of the Spirit. Lord, I take the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. Your Word reminds me of who you are, helps me be aware of my sin, and to know your truth in all things. I will use your word to fight against the Devil, his lies, and his angels. May your Word be a lamp to my feet, a light to my path, may it purify my thoughts and intentions. Today and every day, I will read, remember, and relish what your Word says so that the Gospel will reverberate from my life and help bring others to You.
